Some parents believe hiding a gun is enough. However, 75% of kids who live in homes with guns know exactly where to find them.

If you've got gun in your home:

- Keep it unloaded, locked and out of sight.
- Keep ammunition and guns locked in separate locations.
- Use safety devices, including gun locks, lock boxes and gun safes, for every gun in the house.
- Hide storage keys and lock combinations from children.
- Never leave children unsupervised.

Before visiting friends and relatives, ask if they have guns in their homes. If so, make sure they keep their guns unloaded and locked as well.
